

Pre-Prosecution Diversion Program

The Pre-Prosecution Diversion Program (PPD) provides an opportunity for persons charged with non-violent low-level felonies to participate in a rehabilitation program to repair the harm caused by the offender and to address the underlying causes of the crime committed to reduce the likelihood of it happening again.

The current charge must be for a nonviolent felony offense.

The offender must readily admit guilt and voluntarily submit a statement of admission. The statement of admission must provide adequate information to establish every element of each offense charged.

FOR DWI CASES

- Must be a true 1st Offense
- No Child in the vehicle
- No one injured
- Must Complete DWI Course through the Local DWI Program
- Participate in Random Drug/Alcohol Testing
- Complete a Drug and Alcohol Assessment and Follow Treatment Recommendations
- Complete Community Service Hours
- No Prior Felony Convictions
- No Previous Participation in a Diversion Program in the Past 10 years
