<b>Position/Division: Full-Time</b>	Senior Investigator- This position is primarily assigned to the Deming office, but travel between all three DA offices is required.  (Position classification dependent upon experience)
<b>Salary Range:</b>	Range - \$27.86-\$34.83/hourly (Hiring salary depends on experience and budget availability)
<b>Job Duties:</b>	Incumbent may, depending on Certification and other direction: locate witnesses; serve subpoenas and other process documents; execute warrants; interview witnesses; research investigative leads; provide logistical assistance with witnesses and evidence; testify in court; coordinate efforts with other law enforcement agencies; provide internal security within a District Attorney's Office; execute all powers and duties established by statute pertaining to peace officers; provide training to other investigators; supervise other staff; perform other related job duties.
<b>Knowledge, Skills and Abilities</b>	This position requires advanced knowledge of: criminal law, procedures, tactics and equipment; surveillance techniques; interview and interrogation skills; investigatory skills; supervisory and management skills; writing skills; communication skills; ability to conduct effective training; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other law enforcement agencies and other criminal justice system participants; ability to interact effectively with the public; ability to follow directions and policies of the District Attorney's Office; ability to use the District Attorney's Case Management system; ability to use NCIC if so certified.
<b>Requirements</b>	Associate's degree in criminology, criminal justice, police science or a related field, plus 1 year work experience; or three (3) years' work experience in related field, plus New Mexico Peace Officer Certification at the discretion of the District Attorney.
<b>Preferred Requirements</b>	New Mexico Peace Officer Certification, plus four (4) years' work experience, education and/or training in law enforcement; investigations or related field.
<b>Working Conditions</b>	Work is performed both in the office and in field investigations outside the office; considerable physical effort may be required. May be required to be on-call during non-working hours, at the discretion of the District Attorney. May encounter dangerous situations.
